



## Quick Reference Guide: Using Articulate Storyline with WordPress LMS

The new WordPress LMS plug-in by LearnDash allows you to upload content created with Articulate Storyline. This quick reference guide will outline the steps required to successfully embed Storyline content into your pages using the Tin Can API.

Follow the steps below to install the **One Click Upload for Articulate Storyline** plug-in:

Step	Action
1	Log into your <b>WordPress</b> site and click on <b>Plug-ins &gt; Add New</b>
2	Click on the <b>Upload</b> link at the top of the page
3	Click on the <b>Upload</b> button, then navigate to where you saved the <b>Plug-in</b> file (as of this writing, it is named <b>GrassBladeV0.3.2.zip</b> )
4	After the plug-in has been successfully installed, click the <b>Activate Plug-in</b> link

Follow the steps below to setup your **Wax LRS** Account:

Step	Action
1	Log into your <b>WordPress</b> site and click on <b>Plug-ins &gt; Add New</b>
2	Click on the <b>Upload</b> link at the top of the page
3	Click on the <b>Upload</b> button, then navigate to where you saved the <b>Learning Record Store Plug-in</b> file (as of this writing, it is named <b>sfwd-lrs.zip</b> )
4	After the plug-in is installed, click the <b>Activate Plug-in</b> link
5	Click on the <b>LearnDash LRS</b> menu option in your <b>WordPress</b> dashboard
6	Fill out the required information on the <b>SaltBox Sign-up</b> form that appears
7	Once you are logged in, access your <b>Settings</b> and click on the <b>Create New OAuth</b> and the <b>Create New Basic</b> buttons
8	Copy the <b>Login</b> and <b>Password</b> that are generated under the <b>Basic Credentials</b> section so that you can easily access them when you are configuring you <b>Tin Can</b> settings

Follow the steps below to setup your **Tin Can Settings** in the **WordPress Plug-in**:

Step	Action																
1	Log into your <b>WordPress</b> site																
2	Click on the <b>Courses &gt; Tin Can Settings</b>

## Quick Reference Guide: Using Articulate Storyline with WordPress LMS *Continued*

Follow the steps below to **Publish** your Articulate Storyline for use with the Tin Can API:

Step	Action
1	Open your .story file in Storyline
2	On the <b>Home</b> tab in Storyline and click on <b>Publish</b>
3	When the <b>Publish</b> dialogue box appears, click on the <b>LMS</b> tab
4	On the <b>LMS</b> Drop-down list under the <b>Output Options</b> section, select <b>Tin Can API</b>
5	Click the <b>Publish</b> button
6	After the <b>Publish Successful</b> dialogue box appears, click on the <b>Zip</b> icon to zip the published files

Follow the steps below to **Upload** your Articulate Storyline content into **WordPress**:

Step	Action
1	Log into your <b>WordPress</b> site
2	Click on <b>xAPI content &gt; Add New</b> in the <b>WordPress</b> Dashboard
3	Enter a <b>Title</b> for your <b>xAPI</b> content
4	Click the <b>Choose File</b> button and browse to the location of your <b>Zip</b> file
5	Click the <b>Publish</b> button
6	A <b>URL</b> will be displayed on the screen
<b>Note:</b> Copy this <b>URL</b> to your clip board for use in future steps	

Follow the steps below to **Insert** your Storyline project into a **Lesson**:

Step	Action
1	Log into your <b>WordPress</b> site
2	Click on <b>Lessons &gt; Add New</b>
3	Enter a <b>Title</b> for your lesson
4	Click on the <b>Grassblade</b> icon on the text editor toolbar
5	After the <b>Grassblade - xAPI Shortcode Generator</b> modal appears, select, "I want to add a <b>TinCan/xAPI Content to this page</b> "
6	Paste the <b>URL</b> that was created on the <b>xAPI</b> screen when you uploaded your <b>Zip</b> file earlier into the <b>Content URL</b> field
7	Click the <b>Insert Code</b> button
<b>Result:</b> The <b>URL</b> to your Storyline file will appear in the text editor	
8	Select the course you would like to associate the lesson with under the <b>Manage Course Associations</b> section
9	Click the <b>Publish</b> button

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
